Business Manager Hermes reviewed the federal programs. Federal programs that we participate in for SY 2020-2021 are: Title I Part A, REAP-FLEX, RLIS, Title VI, Impact Aid and JOM. New federal programs/funds this school year due to COVID-19 include the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) and the Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF). The CARES and CRF funds are being used for all COVID related expenses such as additional staff, technology, plexi-glass, masks and hand sanitizer.

We did not receive any input from the attendees.

Our Native American Coordinator Amy Sandquist also provided an update at the board meeting, which immediately followed the Community Input meeting. She stated that she participated in the fall data retreat which reviewed, processed, and discussed our district's current data as well as reviewed prior data and goals. By assessing prior goals and discussions, our teams can make recommendations based on our students needs in order to carry forward with continued growth and success.
